

The Principal Objects of the Association, Hospice of the Valleys

To promote the relief of suffering:-

- (a) By establishing domiciliary Hospice Services.
- (b) By providing residential inpatient care.
- (c) By conducting or promoting or encouraging research.
- (d) By engaging in the education of all healthcare professionals.
- (e) By ensuring appropriate spiritual help and guidance is available when required for any persons under the care of the Association.

The Secondary Objects of the Association

- (a) To purchase, lease, hire and maintain property and equipment necessary for the furtherance of the principal objects of the Association.
- (b) To establish and conduct all clinical services necessary for the relief of suffering.
- (c) To engage and pay such staff whom the Association may think fit for the promotion of its objects.
- (c) To ensure that its clinical services are either free of charge or subject to such payment as the Association may think fit.
- (d) To provide clinical services at any location which the Association may think fit.
- (e) To provide all items needed that are conducive to the physical, material or spiritual welfare of any persons under the care of the Association.
- (f) To provide or arrange for premises to be used by the Association as a place of worship.
- (g) To establish and conduct schools, training colleges and other places of learning and laboratories and other research establishments.
- (h) To arrange lectures and conduct training courses and to publish pamphlets, books, journals and other publications relating to the work of the Association.
- (i) To conduct appeals for money or other gifts or for any other assistance for any of the purposes of the Association.
- (j) To participate in appropriate pension schemes for all employed by the Association.
- (k) To dispose of any of the property of the Association as may be thought expedient with a view to the promotion of its objects.
- (l) To undertake and execute any charitable trusts which the Association may lawfully undertake.
- (m) To borrow or raise money for the purposes of the Association on such terms and on such security as may be thought fit.
- (n) To invest the monies of the Association not immediately required for its purposes.
- (o) To establish and support any charitable associations in any way that may further any of the principle objects of the Association.
- (p) To do all such other lawful things as are necessary for the attainment of the principal objects of the Association.
